

Election of Town Councillors for Yarm Town Council

1. Forms of nomination for the Parish Election may be obtained from Clerk to Parish Council or Municipal Buildings, PO Box 11, Church Road, Stockton-on-Tees, TS18 1LD from the Returning Officer who will, at the request of an elector for any electoral area prepare a nomination paper for signature.
2. Nomination papers must be delivered to the Returning Officer, Municipal Buildings, PO Box 11, Church Road, Stockton-on-Tees, TS18 1LD on any day after the date of this notice but no later than **4 pm on Friday, 24th June 2022.**
3. If any election is contested the poll will take place on **Thursday, 21st July 2022.**
4. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **12 midnight on Tuesday 5 July 2022.** Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote>.
5. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Municipal Buildings, PO Box 11, Church Road, Stockton-on-Tees, TS18 1LD by **5 pm on Wednesday, 6th July 2022.**
6. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Municipal Buildings, PO Box 11, Church Road, Stockton-on-Tees, TS18 1LD by **5 pm on Wednesday, 13th July 2022.**
7. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Municipal Buildings, PO Box 11, Church Road, Stockton-on-Tees, TS18 1LD by **5 pm on Thursday, 21st July 2022.** The physical incapacity must have occurred after **5 pm on Wednesday, 13th July 2022.** To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after **5 pm on Wednesday, 13th July 2022**
